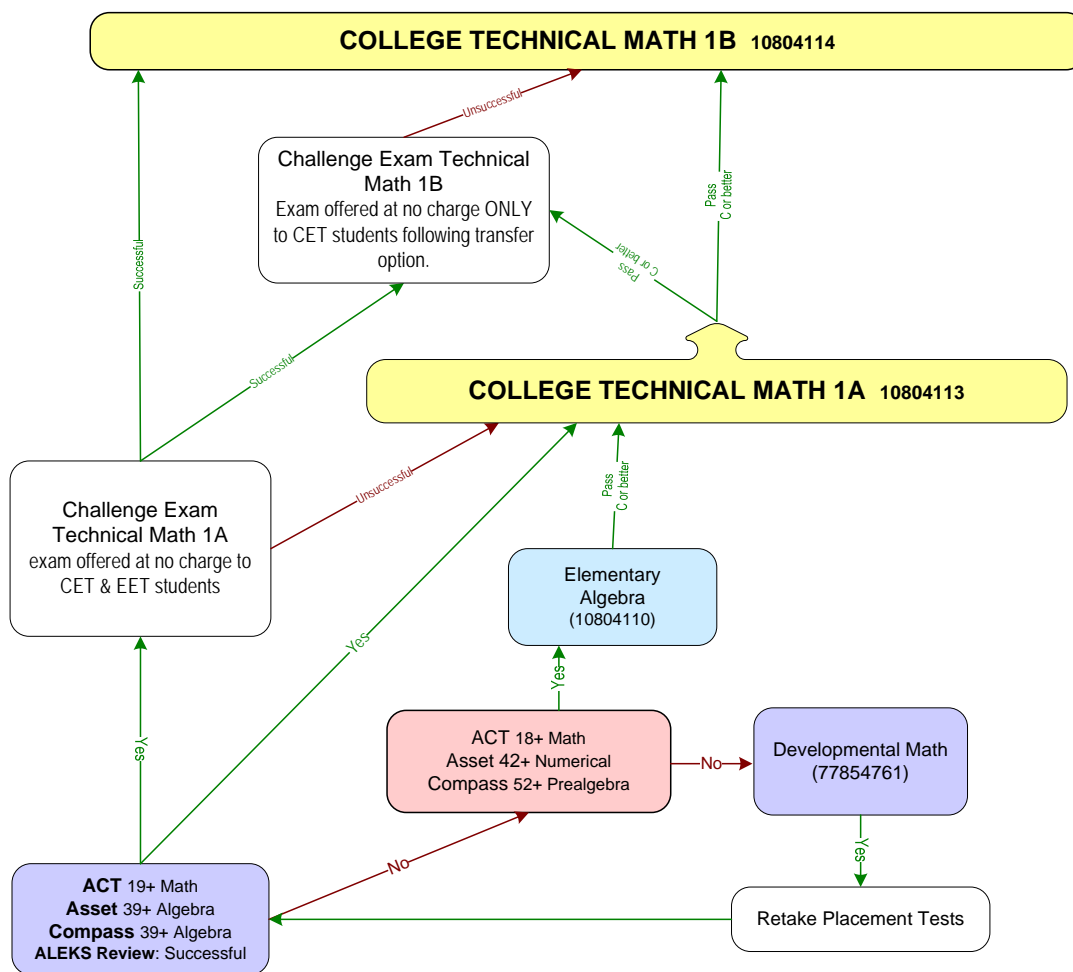


Pathway to Success College Technical Math 1A & B



Prerequisite(s) –

College Tech Math 1A: ACT 19+ (Math), ASSET 39+ (Algebra), COMPASS 39+ (Algebra) OR Elementary Algebra (10804110) with a C or better.

College Tech Math 1B: 10804113 College Technical Math 1A with a "C" or better

The above diagram shows the pathway you must follow to take College Technical Math 1A and College Technical Math 1B (10804113 & 10804114).

If you score ACT 19+ (math), ASSET 39+ (Algebra), COMPASS 39+ (Algebra), you can take College Technical Math 1A (10804113) or choose to take the Challenge Exam for Technical Math 1A. Once you have successfully completed Technical Math 1A (10804113) or the challenge exam, you can take Technical Math 1B (10804114).

If you do not meet the prerequisite listed above, but you score ACT 18+ (Math), ASSET 42+ (Numerical), or COMPASS 52+ (PreAlgebra) you must first take Elementary Algebra (10804110). Once you successfully complete Elementary Algebra (10804110) with a C or better, you can enroll in College Technical Math 1A (10804113). Once you have successfully completed College Technical Math 1A (10804113), you can take College Technical Math 1B (10804114).

If your scores are lower than listed above, you must first take Developmental Math (77854761) through the ISS Division. You then must retake your placement tests to meet the pre-requisite scores or other routes on the pathway.
