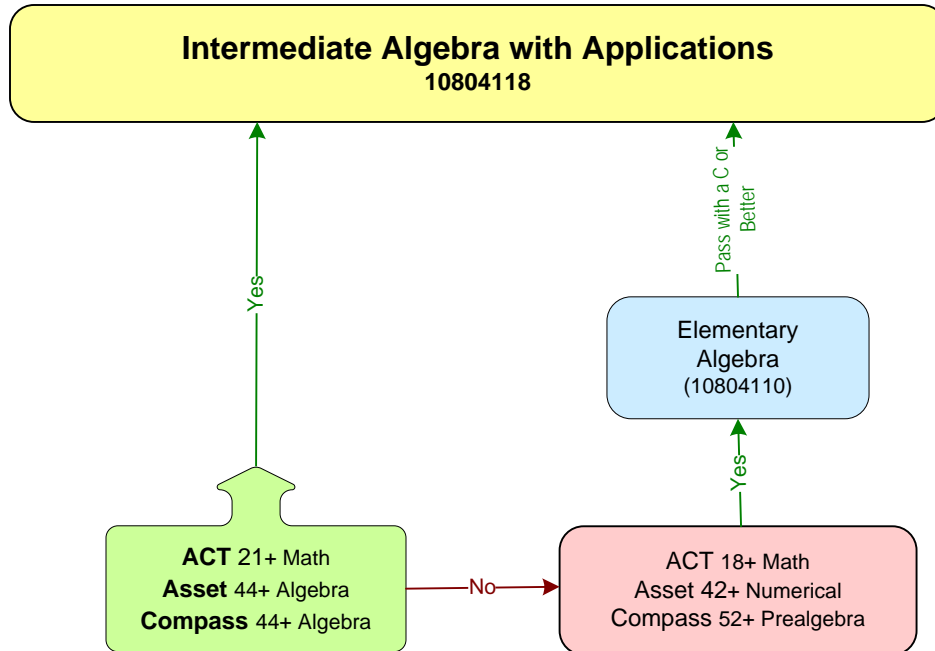


Pathway to Success

Intermediate Algebra with Applications



Prerequisite(s): ACT 21+ (Math), ASSET 44+ (Algebra), COMPASS 44+ (Algebra) or Elementary Algebra (10804110) with a C or better.

The above diagram shows the pathway you must follow in order to take Intermediate Algebra with Applications (10804118).

If you score ACT 21+ (Math), ASSET 44+ (Algebra), COMPASS 44+ (Algebra) then you may take Intermediate Algebra with Applications (10804118).

If you do not meet the scores above, but you score ACT 18+ (Math), ASSET 42+ (Numerical), COMPASS 52+ (PreAlgebra) then you can take Elementary Algebra (10804110). You must pass Elementary Algebra (10804110) with a C or better before you can take Intermediate Algebra with Applications (10804118).
