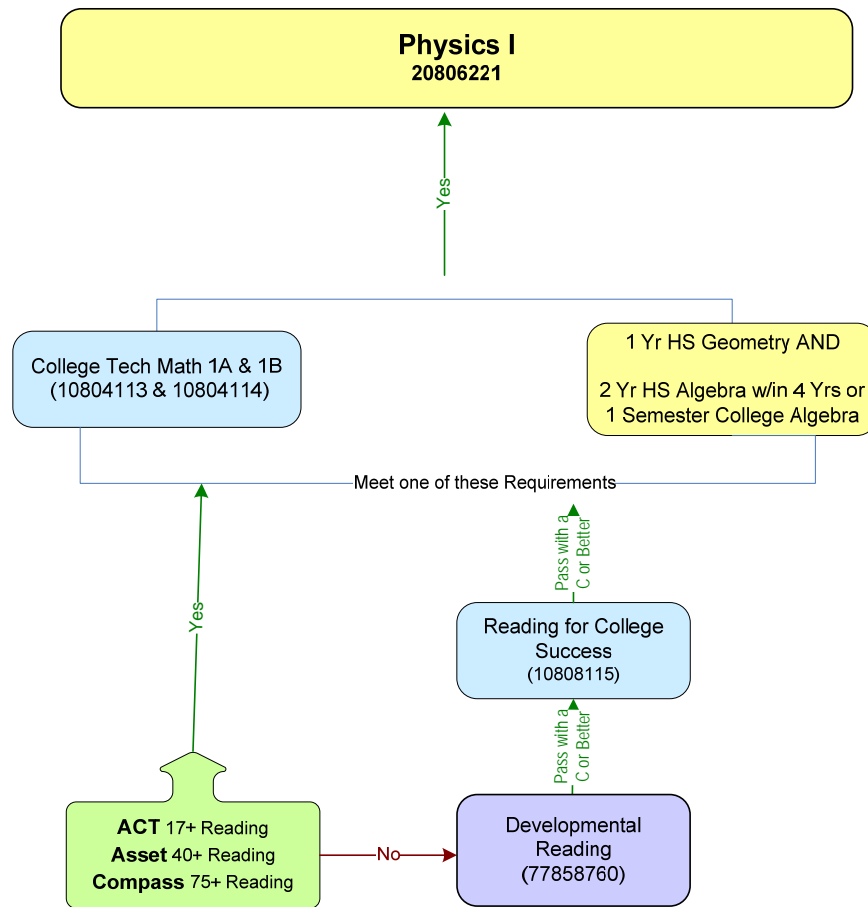


Pathway to Success

Physics I



Prerequisite(s): ACT 17+ (Reading), ASSET 40+ (Reading), COMPASS 75+ (Reading) or Reading for College Success (10808115) or with a C or better **AND** College Tech Math 1 A and 1B with a C or better **OR** 2 Years of High School Algebra within the last 4 years or 1 Semester of College Algebra **AND** 1 Year of High School Geometry.

The above diagram shows the pathway you must follow in order to take Physics I (20806221)

You must meet **ONE** of the following requirements:

Score ACT 17+ (Reading), ASSET 40+ (Reading), COMPASS 75+ (Reading) **OR** successfully complete Reading for College Success (10808115) with a C or better.

If you score lower than the above scores, you must first take Developmental Reading (77858760) through the ISS Division and pass with a C or better before you can take Reading for College Success (10808115).

You must also meet **ONE** of the following requirements:

You either need to have taken One year of high school Geometry and two years of high school algebra within the last four years or one semester of College Algebra **OR** have taken College Technical Math 1A and 1B (10804113 & 10804114) and received a C or better.

If you have met these two requirements, you can take Physics I (20806221).
