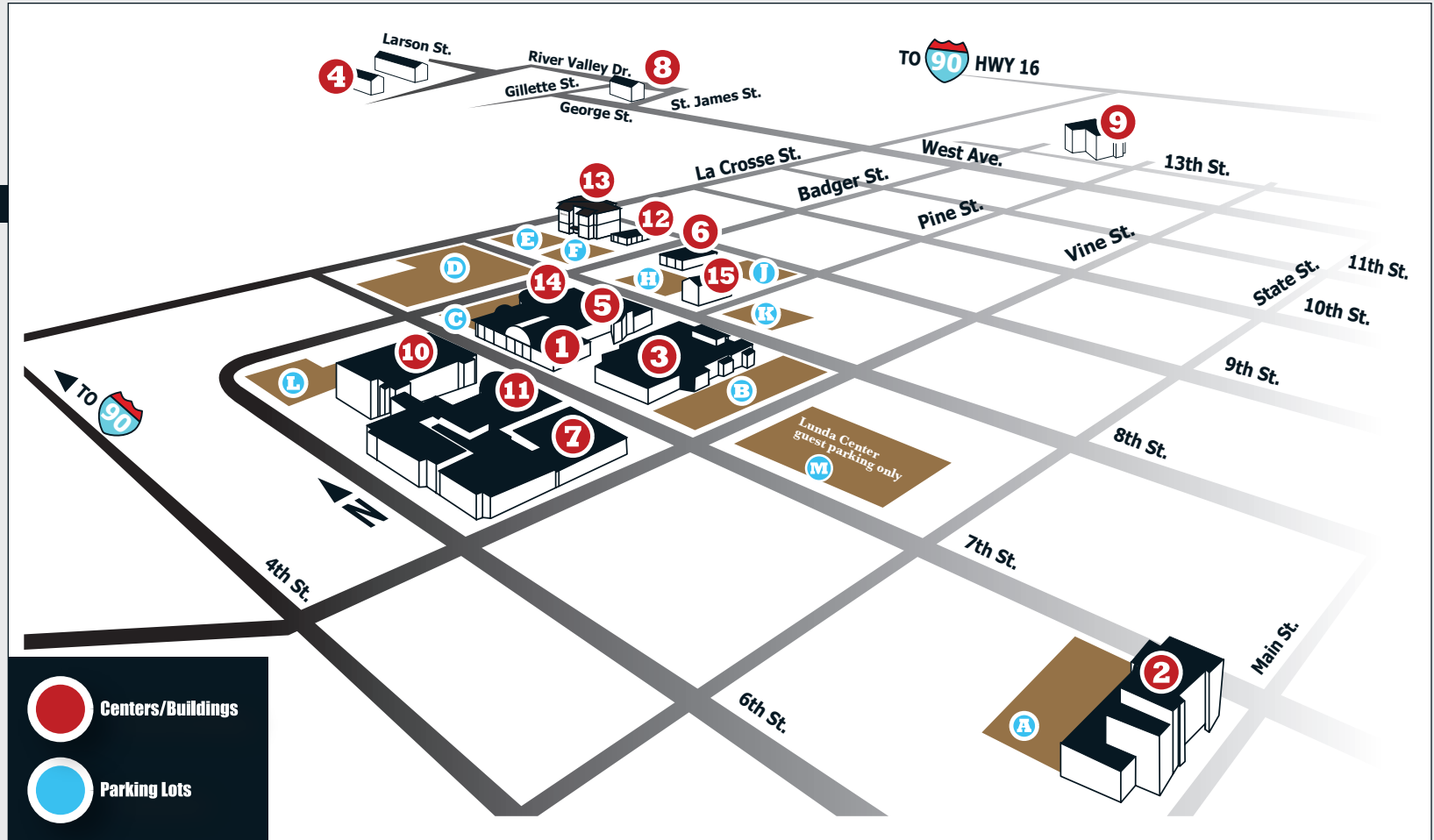

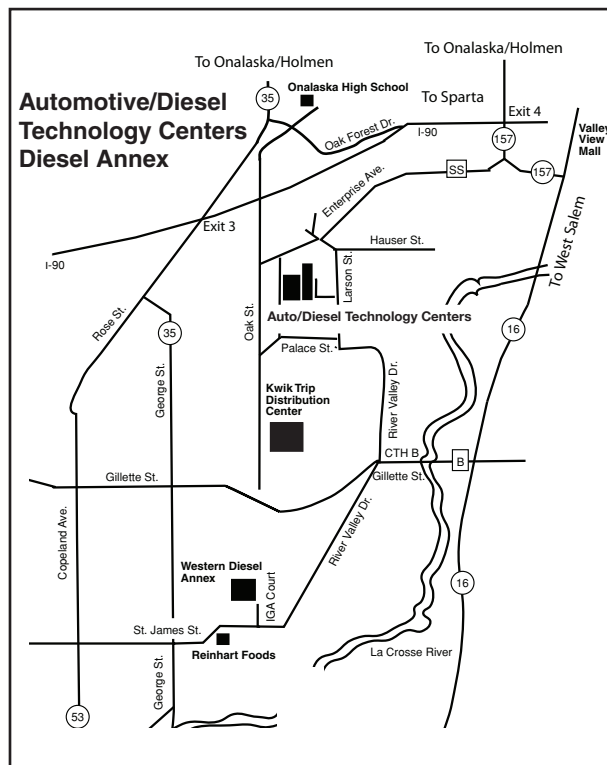

PARKING REGULATIONS

1. **PERMITS** are required on all licensed motor vehicles parked on Western parking lots. See map for locations. Permits are available at K-100. No parking permits needed evenings/weekends and during the summer with the exception of Parking Lot A, L and the Residence Hall lot. Daily permits are also available for \$2.00
2. **Lunda Center** guests only are allowed to park in Lot M.
3. **HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER** parking permits can be purchased with a minimum two-day advance notice. Permits are \$2.00 per/day. Permits can be purchased at the Information Desk in the lobby of HSC.
4. **NO VEHICLE IS TO BE:**
 - a. parked on lawns or sidewalks
 - b. backed into a stall
 - c. parked in a traffic or fire lane
 - d. parked in the courtyard west of Applied Technology Center
 - e. parked in the courtyard behind Coleman Center
5. **NO OVERNIGHT PARKING** except residents of Western Residence Hall and students on school trips who have permits from the Student Life Office.
6. **Vehicles** in violation will be ticketed and/or towed away at owner's expense without warning.
7. **BICYCLES** are not to be chained to trees.
8. **MOTORCYCLE** parking is available in Parking Lot H.
