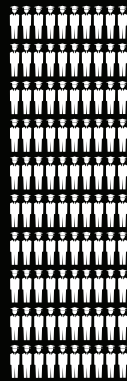

Associate of Science-Liberal Arts (ASLA) Transfer Programs

The ASLA transfer programs are designed to help you on the path to a bachelor's degree whether you are undecided in your career choice, have a specific career in mind, or would like to earn a two-year transfer degree.

ASLA options include:

General Studies Pathway

If you're not sure what major you want to pursue, this is a great, cost-effective way to get started. You will be placed into a student cohort who take set general education classes together for the first year.

Engineering Pathway

This 2+2 transfer agreement with Viterbo University allows you to take general studies and engineering intro classes at Western, then transfer all 64 credits directly into Viterbo's Engineering bachelor's degree as a junior.

Associate of Science-Liberal Arts (ASLA) Full Degree
