How to apply for the EMT Basic or EMT Part 2 course

Step 1: Set up an Application Dashboard

1. Go to: <https://www.westerntc.edu/apply>
2. Click on the Apply Now button
3. Click on the red Sign Up link
4. Enter your first and last name, and personal email
5. Click the Submit button
6. Log into your email account
7. Open the email from Western
8. Click on the very long blue link
9. Create a Password

Step 2: Complete Application

1. In the Application Dashboard, click on the “Next Steps” tab at the top
2. Click blue “Start Application” button
3. Select “Enroll in a Program”
4. Select the term you would like to take the course
5. On the next page, select the “Law, Public Safety, Corrections, & Security” Program Cluster, then the “EMT-Basic” Program
6. Complete application entirely. When at 99% complete, click on “Submit,” THEN on the following page you will check the box and type in your name then click “Verify and Submit.”
