# Request a FREE 2015 TAX RETURN TRANSCRIPT

## **Request for Parent Tax Return Transcript**

- You have been selected for verification by the federal processing center. In order for us to complete this process, we will need a copy of your parent's federal tax transcript (we are not able to accept federal 1040 tax returns).
- If your parents are married and filed separately or not married but living together; please provide both parents' tax return transcripts.

#### **Data Retrieval (Recommended)**

Go to <u>www.fafsa.gov</u> and click on make a correction. Before financial information, click on blue rectangle that says "Link to IRS".



### **Print Tax Return Transcript Now**

- Visit <u>www.irs.gov</u> Under Tools tab, click "Get a Tax Transcript"; then "Get Transcript Online".
  - To create an account, you must have either a personal account number from a credit card, mortgage, home equity loan, home equity line of credit or car loan, and a mobile phone with your name on the account.
  - IRS will send user a confirmation code via email and an authentication code via text. Email contains one-time code user will use to "Get Transcript Online" – immediately receive tax return transcript.

#### MAIL – IRS Form 4506T

- Request for Tax Return Transcript.

- ◆ Tax filers must follow the prompts and enter the following information:
  - Social Security number.
  - $\circ$   $\,$  The street address that was listed on the latest tax return filed.
  - Select "Option 2" to request an IRS Return Transcript.
  - Select "2015" for the tax year.

- This service is free and you will receive your transcript immediately.
- Be sure to request a Tax Return Transcript.

# **Additional Information**

- If you are married and you and your spouse filed *separate* <u>2015</u> tax returns, you must submit a tax return transcript for both you and your spouse. The same applies if both parents filed a separate **2015** tax return.
- Please do NOT request to have your transcript sent directly to the Office of Student Financial Aid from the IRS.
- Requesting your transcript to be mailed online may take 5-10 days from the date requested. Paper Requests require 3-4 weeks.
- If your 2015 W-2 forms are being requested, you may also request a Wage and Income Transcript.
- Note: If you have an Amended Tax Return, you will need to request both the IRS Tax Return Transcript and the IRS Tax Account Transcript (Record of Account). You can do this by following the steps above, once requesting the Tax Return Transcript and a second time by requesting the IRS Tax Account Transcript.

# Potential problems that may cause you to NOT be able to request/receive an IRS Tax Return Transcript:

- If you owe money to the IRS, you will not be eligible to request a Tax Return Transcript until that balance is paid in <u>full</u>. (Including 2015 and prior tax years)
- If you are having problems with your address not matching please go to <u>www.usps.com</u> (United States Postal Service)
