Unusual Enrollment History

- 2) If you did not earn academic credit at EACH institution you attended during this time frame, please provide a letter outlining the reason(s) you failed to earn academic credit. Third party documentation of this explanation may be required. Academic credit is considered to be earned if the academic records show that the student completed any credit hours or clock hours.

Documentation will be reviewed and you will be notified of an official decision in writing. Providing all requested documentation does not guarantee student eligibility. If you did not earn academic credit at each institution attended and you are unable to provide sufficient explanation and documentation of the circumstances that led to the failure(s), you will be ineligible to receive further financial aid.
