PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

for

Transfer of Credit

between

Silver Lake College and Wisconsin Technical College System

This partnership agreement applies to applicants to Silver Lake College who have received an Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree or an Associate in Applied Arts (A.A.A.) degree from a Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) institution and are interested in completing a Silver Lake College Bachelor's degree.

This partnership agreement between Silver Lake College and the Wisconsin Technical College System provides an educational opportunity for students of the Wisconsin Technical College System to continue their studies and earn a Bachelor's Degree at Silver Lake College.

Silver Lake College accepts transfer associate-level credits from the Wisconsin Technical College System when:

1. The student has earned an Associate Degree (a minimum of 60 credits will apply toward requirements of the Bachelor's degree)
2. The course content from the Wisconsin Technical College System institution is:
 - a. Similar to Silver Lake College courses, as determined from time to time by the appropriate departments at Silver Lake College in consultation with the Silver Lake College Registrar
 - b. Applies to the Silver Lake College curriculum (program and/or electives)
 - c. The student has received a grade of "C" or better (2.75 GPA is required for education majors)
3. Silver Lake College coursework includes:
 - a. Completion of 24 credits in Liberal Arts Studies at Silver Lake College
 - b. At least 30 credits must be earned at Silver Lake College
 - c. Successful completion of requirements for one Silver Lake College major
4. Once the student and his/her advisor develop a mutually agreed upon plan, Silver Lake College will provide courses as the plan dictates. Schedules are prepared after a careful analysis of course needs for each student admitted to Silver Lake College. Therefore, all courses are not offered every term. With this approach, however,

every student can expect to have courses available that will accommodate his/her plan.


5. Once a student is admitted to Silver Lake College, the accepted degree plan is guaranteed to the student even if subsequent changes in the curriculum occur, provided the student has maintained continuous enrollment in the program. Continuous enrollment is defined as completion of one three-credit course in each term. There is no maximum time within which the degree must be completed providing a student maintains continuous enrollment.

Information for advising in specific program transfers will be developed and updated by the appropriate departments at Silver Lake College and the Wisconsin Technical College System.


