**MASTER OF SCIENCE IN NURSING – CLINICAL NURSE EDUCATOR
ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**

Carroll University acknowledges the course offerings and preparation of graduates from the Wisconsin Technical College System in an Associate of Applied Science in Nursing degree program. Therefore:

1. Students entering the Master of Science in Nursing Program at Carroll University will receive junior standing for their Associate of Applied Science in Nursing degree provided said degree includes appropriate program and grade requirements as set forth by Carroll University, including but not limited to:
 - a. A cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher
 - b. Grades of C or better in all required biology, chemistry, health science and nursing courses
2. Wisconsin Technical College System courses will transfer in accordance with established Carroll University transfer procedures as updated and modified periodically by the academic departments.
3. Opportunities exist to start coursework in the ADN to MSN program at Carroll University prior to completion of the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing degree.
4. Wisconsin Technical College System students who have graduated from an Associate of Applied Science in Nursing degree program will be awarded up to 70 credits at Carroll University in recognition of the scholarship and competence achieved as a Registered Nurse.
5. Courses completed at institutions other than the Wisconsin Technical College System will be evaluated separately.
6. Successful participation in the Master of Science in Nursing Program requires that the candidate be in compliance with the Technical Standards for Admission and Progression as well as the Academic Progression Standards as published in the Carroll University catalog.
7. Upon successful completion of the Master of Science in Nursing Program candidates will be awarded both the Bachelor of Science in Nursing and the Master of Science in Nursing degrees.
8. Both Carroll University and the Wisconsin Technical College System can market this agreement.

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN NURSING – CLINICAL NURSE EDUCATOR

A Carroll University Master of Science in Nursing - Clinical Nurse Educator degree provides an opportunity for professional nurses to develop specialty practice to teach in the classroom, clinical and simulation setting. The MSN program offers a track for baccalaureate educated registered nurses as well as an ADN to MSN career pathway.

The goals of the MSN-Clinical Nurse Educator degree are to develop MSNs who can:

- Design, implement, and evaluate nursing curricula consistent with mission, goals and program outcomes/objectives of educational institutions
- Exercise leadership skills and manage collaborative efforts in educational settings
- Translate evidence into practice

Carroll's curriculum will advance nurses interested in working in an academic or clinical setting through coursework that requires facilitation of classes or laboratory simulation in BSN courses. MSN graduates will be eligible to sit for the National League for Nursing's Certified Nurse Educator certification.

The MSN program builds upon Carroll University's mission of providing a superior education, rooted in its Presbyterian and liberal arts heritage and draws upon its Christian tradition to prepare all students for vocational success, lifelong learning and service in a diverse and global society. The mission of the Carroll University Department of Nursing is to educate professional nurses at the baccalaureate and master's level.

Accreditation

Carroll University is accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. The baccalaureate in Nursing Program at Carroll is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). The CCNE is a nationally recognized accrediting agency devoted exclusively to the evaluation of baccalaureate and graduate programs in nursing education. Carroll's nursing program received accreditation December 2010 through December 2020 with no deficiencies.

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
