TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT Northland College and Wisconsin Technical College System

Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) program:

Early Childhood Education – Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree to Northland College

– Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in Elementary/Middle-Education

This agreement is an articulation between the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) Early Childhood Education Program and the Northland College Elementary/Middle-Education Program.

Purpose

The purpose of this articulation is to facilitate credit transfer and to provide a smooth transition from one related degree program to another. This agreement can also be used for providing Early Childhood Education program students a route to state teaching licensure. Students in the Northland College program will major in Elementary/Middle-Education and must complete a minimum of six credits in the Early Childhood minor at Northland College.

Conditions and Limitations

The terms of this agreement apply only for the purpose of entry to the B.S. in Elementary/Middle-Education at Northland College for WTCS students who have:

- 1. Successfully completed the A.A.S. degree in Early Childhood Education with a minimum grade point average of 2.75.
- 2. Completed the courses outlined in this agreement (or approved equivalents)
- 3. Met the transfer admission requirements of Northland College current at the time of application
- 4. Courses must be graded with a C- or higher to be accepted for transfer at Northland College.

Once admitted to Northland College, students must meet the degree and teacher licensure requirements as stated in the catalog in effect at the time of admission to Northland College.

According to the Northland College catalog, a maximum of 60 credits will be accepted toward the B.S. degree in Elementary/Middle-Education. The attached chart identifies the WTCS required program courses as well as possible general studies courses with the Northland College equivalencies.

This agreement may be amended as necessary to reflect changes in program and general education courses at either institution. Students will be made aware of the current requirements at the time of their enrollment.

Advising

Northland College and the WTCS colleges will provide academic advising to WTCS college learners inquiring about Northland College's programs. Learners will be connected with a Northland College advisor prior to transfer. Northland College and WTCS colleges will share materials, catalogs, and other information to facilitate the understanding of requirements and programs. WTCS colleges will assist Northland College in arranging recruitment events on its campuses.

Marketing

Any marketing of this agreement will be subject to the prior approval of Northland College and the WTCS colleges and will adhere to each institutions standards for the use of its name and logo. Each institution will assume

responsibility for appropriate marketing to reach its student population. Each institution may provide a link to this agreement and/or the other institution(s) on its website, with notice to the other party.
