Articulation Agreement – WTCS A.A.S. Early Childhood Education to Viterbo University B.S. Elementary Education

This Articulation Agreement (the "Agreement") by and between Viterbo University ("VU"), with its principal address at 900 Viterbo Drive, La Crosse, Wisconsin, and Wisconsin Technical College System ("WTCS") Early Childhood Education programs, is entered to facilitate the seamless transfer of students between WTCS and VU and to raise students' awareness of the opportunities afforded by this Agreement. Accordingly, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants contained in this Agreement, VU and WTCS (collectively "the Parties") agree as follows:

Terms of the Agreement

- 1. WTCS students who have successfully completed the courses listed in the transfer guides (shown in Addendum A and B) and who apply for admission and meet VU's standard admission criteria are guaranteed transferability of academic coursework as listed on the transfer guide. WTCS students who have successfully completed an Associate Degree must have completed the VU requirements as shown on the transfer guides. The list of courses on Addendum A and B may be revised from time to time as necessitated by curricula changes at the party institutions or by agreement of the academic deans overseeing the affected programs. VU and WTCS will collaborate to ensure continued alignment of lesson plan templates and curriculum components.
- The student must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.25 on a 4.0 scale at WTCS, with a grade of C or higher in all courses, in order to receive the benefits of this articulation agreement.
- 3. Additional general education courses, or other courses pertaining to VU's Elementary Education program, may possibly transfer and count towards the degree. This will be decided on a case-by-case basis.
- 4. Students who have not completed the associate degree will be evaluated on an individual basis.
- 5. In order for courses to transfer, the student must have completed the courses within the last five (5) years of being admitted to VU.
- 6. In order to enter student teaching, the student must have earned a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher at Viterbo.
- 7. In order to be endorsed for licensure upon completion of the degree requirements, the student must earn a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher at Viterbo.
- 8. VU requires, among other requirements, that all of its candidates for the bachelor's degree accomplish the following:
 - a. fulfill its core curriculum/general education requirements;

- b. complete all courses required for its major(s) and minor(s), if applicable
- c. earn a minimum of 120 credits;
- d. earn a minimum of 40 upper-division credits (courses numbered 300 and higher) for the depending on Viterbo Univ. program;
- e. complete a minimum of the last 30 consecutive credits at Viterbo University, including alternative credits (CLEP, portfolio).
- f. To earn the Bachelor of Science degree, students must complete 11 credits of natural science and/or mathematics.

Services Provided to WTCS ECE by Viterbo University

- Onsite or online advising services
- Annual updates to the transfer guide

Services Provided to Viterbo University by WTCS ECE

- The opportunity for representatives to meet with WTCS students on an ongoing basis
- Assistance in the distribution of updated degree and transfer materials to alumni and current students
- Posting of the transfer guides and other college information on the transfer website to market opportunities for students

Longevity of Agreement and Conditions for Change

- This agreement shall remain in force until terminated by either party, with or
 without cause, upon 60 days written notice to the other party. Upon
 termination of this agreement, students previously admitted to VU pursuant to
 this Agreement shall continue to receive the benefits contemplated by this
 Agreement and the applicable VU catalog for a period not to exceed four (4)
 years. Proposed changes in policies or curricula by either party will be
 communicated annually.
- Transfer guides and literature will be updated on an annual basis. In the event of
 cancellation of this articulation agreement, ninety-day notice must be given and
 both parties agree to continue to honor the terms of this agreement until any
 cohorts that are currently taking classes have completed their sequence of
 courses.

Effective Date: This agreement is effective on the date fully executed below and takes effect for students beginning fall 2021.
