**Articulation Agreement between
Bryant & Stratton College
And
Wisconsin Technical College System**

PURPOSE

The Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) and Bryant & Stratton College (BSC), in order to maximize the opportunities for students completing an Associate Degree in Nursing at a WTCS College, and to secure eligibility for admission to BSC in the RN to Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program, do hereby enter into the following articulation agreement.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The parties of this agreement, WTCS and BSC, hereby agree to the terms and conditions set forth herein.

- Graduates from the WTCS Colleges must meet the same standards and criteria for admission to the BSC RN to BSN Program as BSC students. Graduates from the WTCS Colleges will follow BSC transfer process and therefore must meet all applicable deadlines and requirements regarding admission, advising, registration, payment of tuition and fees. The graduates will be responsible for adhering to all BSC policies and procedures.
- Credits will transfer to BSC as indicated in the attached degree plans. A grade of "C" or better is required for any course to transfer to BSC. Transfer credits may not exceed 75% of the total 122 credits required for conferral of the BSN (not to exceed 91 credits). Individual review of WTCS nursing graduates' transcripts may occur by BSC personnel as necessary to maximize credit transfer, meet student learning needs, and comply with the agreement.
- A total of at least 122 credit hours are needed to confer the BSN degree at BSC.
- Representatives from both institutions will confer at least on an annual basis to evaluate the success of this agreement. Should content change occur in a transferable course, the school making the change agrees to notify the other school in writing so that this agreement can be re-evaluated. Notice of change will be provided at least 45 days prior to the beginning of the semester in which the change is implemented. Any program changes will be identified and incorporated into subsequent agreements.
- Each institution may carry out publications and marketing of this agreement. This can include, but is not limited to, printed material, websites, and inclusion in admissions material.

AMENDMENTS AND TERMINATION

- This agreement becomes effective upon the signing of both parties and shall continue in effect until both parties agree in writing to modify or terminate the agreement.
- This agreement may be terminated by either party by giving written notice of said party's intention to those listed on the title page of this agreement. Immediate termination may occur if either BSC or the College within the WTCS loses their accreditation status. If a Nursing Program at any college in this agreement loses accreditation, transfer for graduates from that Nursing Program to BSC will be denied.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF COLLEGES

- BSC will provide enrollment, admission, and other academic information to the Nursing students at WTCS Colleges upon expressed interest in BSC RN to BSN Program. Such students may be placed on BSC mailing lists to provide invitations to students and graduates to attend BSC social and cultural events or activities.
- The WTCS Colleges will agree to display or distribute accurate articulation agreement information to its nursing students and graduates in collaboration with BSC.

A signed copy of this agreement shall be maintained by each institution at designated office of WTCS Colleges and BSC.
