MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

**THE COLLEGES OF THE WISCONSIN TECHNICAL COLLEGE SYSTEM
AND
MARIAN UNIVERSITY**

This articulation agreement establishes a cooperative relationship between Marian University (Marian) and the Colleges of the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) that will assist all schools in better serving the educational needs of transfer students. The agreement sets forth policies and procedures by which WTCS students may become eligible to enroll in bachelor programs offered at Marian. The transfer policies described herein will be in effect upon date of signature for WTCS graduates with completion dates from May 2014. The agreement will be renewed at five-year intervals, with content changes as deemed appropriate by the parties.

Note: Marian reserves the right to make policy revisions, which may affect the contents of this agreement due to changes in the curriculum or quality standards at Marian or a WTCS member institution.
