Appendix C

Professional Pathways

Western Wisconsin Technical System

and

Viterbo University

Professional Pathways allows opportunities for students from any technical school in Wisconsin, to build in bachelor degree requirements, which may allow a seamless pathway into the BSN Completion program at Viterbo University.

This is designed for students waiting to start nursing core courses at the Technical School. Students will be eligible to apply for financial aid at Viterbo, so long as the student is not taking courses at any other institution and has not applied for aid elsewhere. The last 30 credits of the bachelor's degree must be taken at Viterbo.

To apply: The following enrollment requirements must be completed and the form must be signed by the Associate Dean of the student's respective nursing program. In addition, an application to the university must be submitted. This form and all documents listed below must be submitted to Viterbo's Office of Admissions. Program Requirements:

____ Transcripts of all lower level courses reviewed by the Associate Dean; minimum 3.0 GPA.

____ All official transcripts from the Technical School, and all other college/universities should be mailed to Viterbo's Center for Adult Learning.

____ Completed Anatomy and Physiology **and** either Advanced Anatomy and Physiology or Microbiology, with a minimum grade of "C" in both courses.

____ 15 credits of general education requirements completed, to include: Written Communication, Speech, Sociology, Psychology, & Developmental Psych; minimum 3.0 GPA.

**To remain a student in the Pathway Programs, a minimum of 3.0 GPA must be maintained.*

BACCALAUREATE DEGREE COMPLETION PROGRAM AGREEMENT

between

Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS)

and

Viterbo University

This articulation agreement establishes a collaborative relationship with Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) and Viterbo University, allowing students with an Associate Degree in Nursing a seamless transfer of credits toward the completion of a bachelor of science in nursing. This agreement establishes guidelines by which WTCS students may transfer courses to Viterbo University after the completion of an associate degree in nursing.

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Completion program encourages nurses to build on their prior learning experiences while fulfilling the requirements of the nursing and core curriculum (general education) at Viterbo. Viterbo's BSN Completion program calendar year is divided into two semesters with a third semester's work being completed in the summer. Each semester is then divided into two sessions. There are various program delivery options providing sufficient credits in order for nurses to graduate in two years. However, students may choose to take fewer credits each semester to complete the program.

The BSN Completion program allows students who have completed the ADN program with any WTCS school to transfer their associate degree in nursing and any other associate level credits to Viterbo University.

CONDITIONS:

1. This articulation agreement is based on the WTCS curricula beginning 1996 to present including all revisions up to the current statewide curriculum. Individuals graduating prior to 1996 will have their transcripts evaluated on an individual basis in a similar manner.
2. All courses transferred from WTCS will be processed as lower division credit.
3. Students will be awarded the amount of credit they earned from the WTCS for transferred coursework, not the number of credits for the equivalent Viterbo course.
4. WTCS and Viterbo University will notify each other of any courses modification(s) which may affect this agreement.
5. Transfer credits will be granted for WTCS courses in which the transfer student has received a grade of C or better.
6. General education and nursing courses will be transferred according to Appendix A.
7. All Viterbo University requirements must be met according to Appendix B.
8. When credits are transferred to Viterbo University, the transfer does not include grades. WTCS coursework will not be a part of the Viterbo grade point average calculation.
9. Alternative avenues for earning credits include Credit for Prior Learning, CLEP or other avenues approved by Viterbo University.
10. In addition, students may take core curriculum courses at Viterbo prior to completion of the associate degree through a Professional Pathway option according to Appendix C.

Articulation Agreement
between

Purpose of Agreement

The purpose of this Agreement is to facilitate cooperative educational programming between Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) and Viterbo University. Articulation eliminates unnecessary duplication of instruction, provides opportunities for advanced education, increases flexibility in scheduling, and promotes more informed career decision-making.

Type of Agreement

Program – to – Program

General Terms

Duration: This agreement shall be in effect for an indefinite time period commencing on April ____, 2017.

Review: This Agreement may be reviewed as needed and as agreed to by the provider and recipient.

Modification: This Agreement may be amended or updated at any time upon the mutual agreement in writing of the parties.

Termination: Either agency may terminate this agreement upon six months' notice. Such action, however, shall not affect students already enrolled in the program.

Severability: If any provision of this agreement shall be determined to be void, invalid, unenforceable, or illegal for any reason, it shall be ineffective only to the extent of such prohibition and the validity and enforceability of all remaining provisions shall not be affected thereby.
